Payment Details

For Weekly or Daily Reservations, all fees are due when the dates are Reserved. We ask that you give us at least one day heads up to Reserving your child's spot. And please let us know immediately if you need to cancel.

For Segment Reservations, payment will be due on a week to week basis, we are requiring a one month (segment) at a time commitment. When you register for our distance learning support program, we are committing that spot to your child. Therefore, we are requiring a financial commitment for the entire month. A \$200 reservation fee is required when registering and will be credited \$50 per week towards Learning Stable fees.

We ask that you inform us as soon as possible if you will not continue through the next month so we can offer that spot to the next family on the waiting list. If you do not inform us in writing via email, you will be financially responsible for the coming month. If we can fill the spot, we will refund any payments made.

Other Details

Ages: 9 and up. Students must be reasonably self-disciplined for this program. While we will support the learning process and certainly help students with questions to the best of our ability, this is not meant as tutoring. The learning piece will remain the responsibility of the student's teacher and parent. A minimum of 8 students is required to hold this program with a maximum of 16 students.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What will the schedule look like?

A: It is believed every school and every teacher will have a different schedule and our schedule will be based on your child's schedule. At this time, it is impossible the determine a specific schedule. We expect that during regular school hours the kids will be on their computers doing their assignments or quiet individualized work. We know this will look different for most of the kids and we will adjust as needed. We will take time for lunch, outside fun, brain breaks, snacks, and more.

We will ask you to send us copies of their schedules as soon as they are available.

After their scheduled assignments are completed, we will put together horse care, group riding and other horse camp type activities each day. Again, it is not yet known exactly how the general day will flow but we plan on having some fun!

Q: If my child finishes their assignments early, can they participate in other activities while the other kids finish?

A: Students will be asked to bring something to read or quietly work on while everyone finishes. We always have work puzzles and coloring sheets available as well as some quiet games. Once the majority are done for the day, we will begin our "after school" activities.

Q: What will my child need to bring?

A: They will need their computers and headphones, all needed school supplies, lunches with water or other drinks and any quiet activities for if they finish early. We will supply a mid-morning and mid-afternoon snack. As always, we will have water available .

Q: Will you have sufficient Wi-Fi?

A: Yes, we have adequate Wi-Fi.

Q: Will the kids need to have headsets and wear them all during the classes?

A: Yes, they will need headsets. They will wear them as needed or as required by their teachers.

Q: Will the students be sitting at the bench style tables while learning?

A: The students will each have an assigned space at a table with their own chair. The tables are marked off in a way that there is never any face to face exposures and there are never more than 2 children at each table. For this program, we will limit our numbers to 16 children which allows for safe distancing while in the club house. Each child will have a cubby to store their supplies overnight. We will recommend that computers and other valuables be taken home at night.

Q: Will there be a daily rate?

A: If there are open spots, we will announce the opportunity for daily, drop in type attendance. The daily rate if this occurs will be \$75 per day.

Q: Will you continue to hold the Learning Stable if schools open back up?

A: As long as we have interest and 8 or more students committed, we will continue to offer this service!
